Open to members with a mounted certification of C1 and above

Priority will be given to C2 and above certified members, with open spots being filled by C1 members on a first come basis. Priority will also be given to all DSR applicants before out of region applicants.

Mounted Prep Fee: DSR Members \$200 (\$150 clinic + \$50 for stabling/2 bags shavings)

Out of Region Members: \$275.00 (\$225 clinic + \$50 for stabling/2 bags shavings)

Unmounted Only Fee: DSR Members \$50 Out of Region Members \$75

NOTE: Fee is non-refundable unless the clinic spot can be filled.

Registration Deadline: May 20th

A late fee of \$25.00 will be added to all applications received after May 20th or are incomplete. Clinic space cannot be guaranteed if application is received after the due date or is incomplete.

General Information: The mounted prep will consist of mounted lessons plus HM. Mounted lessons will consist of one flat lesson and two jump lessons (grid/stadium or xc) for EV/HSE certifications and 3 flat lessons for DR certification. The Unmounted portion will include longing, teaching, wraps and more if time allows.

Tentative schedule: Move in will be Friday am June 7th. Ride times and schedules will be announced after entries are in. Move in allowed Thursday afternoon for an extra \$15.00 stall fee.

***D members are welcome to audit and help with jump crew. We will need some D members Friday for the HM portion. ***

Hookups: Available at Lagniappe for \$25/night. Must contact Dawn Kelley for reservations (225-620-2109 or purplereinfarms@yahoo.com). There are only 8 hook up spots with electricity. Please be prepared to use a generator if all hookups are taken. Payment will be collected by Dawn if not sent in with entry form. Checks need to be written to Lagniappe Equestrian Center.

Grounds Fee: Grounds fee of \$10 per day if not stabling at Lagniappe.
