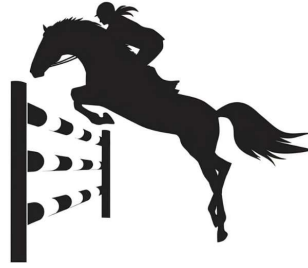

- ❖ **Classes will run in conjunction with the Deep South Region's USPC Qualifying Show Jumping Rally and will follow the USPC rally format.**
- ❖ Tentative schedule-Open Show Jumping rides will be conducted on Saturday, April 20, 2024.
- ❖ Show Jumping rounds will run from high to low and rounds in each division will be run at separate times.
- ❖ Barns open Friday, April 19th @ 12 pm.

### DEEP SOUTH REGION'S SHOW GROUND RULES

- ❖ **Smoking Policy:** Smoking is not allowed on the Show Grounds and in barn areas.
- ❖ **Dog Policy:** For the safety of our competitors and spectators please keep dogs on a leash at all times and may be requested to be removed from area by rally officials due to any safety concerns/disruptive behavior.
- ❖ **ALL Motorized vehicles** on show grounds must be operated by a licensed driver.
- ❖ **COGGINS:** A 12-month negative Coggins dated April 22, 2023 or later must be included with all entries.
- ❖ **LONGEING:** This will be limited to the open area between the large jump arena and the show barns. In compliance with USPC guidelines, the person longeing should wear a helmet and paddock boots (or similar footwear).
- ❖ **SCHOOLING:** Available only in designated warm up areas. Schooling is not permitted in the show arenas.
- ❖ **ATTIRE:** A protective helmet with a secure retention system is required when mounted. Casual & tidy with proper foot attire.
- ❖ **CONCESSIONS:** A food truck is scheduled to be on grounds for the show.
- ❖ **RALLY T-SHIRTS:** Shirts commemorating this rally are available by preorder only. Use the Order Form included with this packet.

A number of inherent risks are associated with a domesticated animal activity. A domesticated animal may behave in a manner that results in damages to property or an injury or death to a person. Risks associated with the activity may include injuries caused by bucking, biting, stumbling, rearing, trampling, scratching, pecking, falling, or butting.

The domesticated animal may react unpredictably to conditions, including, but not limited to, a sudden movement, loud noise, an unfamiliar environment, or the introduction of unfamiliar persons, animals, or objects.

The domesticated animal may also react in a dangerous manner when a condition or treatment is considered hazardous to the welfare of the animal; a collision occurs with an object or animal; or a participant fails to exercise reasonable care, take adequate precautions, or use adequate control when engaging in a domesticated animal activity, including failing to maintain reasonable control of the animal or failing to act in a manner consistent with the person's abilities.

## KANSAS

**KS ST § 60-4001 - 4004 WARNING:** Under Kansas law, there is no liability for an injury to or the death of a participant in domestic animal activities resulting from the inherent risks of domestic animal activities, pursuant to K.S.A. 60-4001 through 60-4004. You are assuming the risk of participating in this domestic animal activity.

Inherent risks of domestic animal activities include, but shall not be limited to:

(1) The propensity of a domestic animal to behave in ways i.e., running, bucking, biting, kicking, shying, stumbling, rearing, falling or stepping on, that may result in an injury, harm or death to persons on or around them; (2) the unpredictability of a domestic animal's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; (3) certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions; (4) collisions with other domestic animals or objects; and (5) the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the domestic animal or not acting within such participant's ability.

## KENTUCKY

**KY ST § 247.401 - 4029 WARNING:** Under Kentucky law, a farm animal activity sponsor, farm animal professional, or other person does not have the duty to eliminate all risks of injury of participation in farm animal activities. There are inherent risks of injury that you voluntarily accept if you participate in farm animal activities.

"Inherent risk" with regard to equine or livestock activities means those dangers or conditions which are an integral part of equine or livestock activities, which may include: (a) the propensity of the animal to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around them; (b) the unpredictability of the animal's reaction to outside stimulation such as sounds, sudden movement, and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; (c) collisions with other animals or objects; or (d) the potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the animal or not acting within his or her ability.

## VERMONT

Each participant shall have the sole individual responsibility for knowing the range of his or her own ability to manage, care for, and control a particular horse or perform a particular equestrian activity, and it shall be the duty of each participant to act within the limits of the participant's own ability, to maintain reasonable control of the particular horse or horses at all times while participating in an equestrian activity, to heed all posted warnings, to perform equestrian activities only in an area or in facilities designated by the horseman and to refrain from acting in a manner which may cause or contribute to the injury of anyone. If while actually riding in an equestrian event, any participant collides with any object or person, except an obviously intoxicated person of whom the horseman is aware, or if the participant falls from the horse or from a horse-drawn conveyance, the responsibility for such collision or fall shall be solely that of the participant or participants involved and not that of the horseman.

## WISCONSIN

**WSA 895.481 NOTICE:** A person who is engaged for compensation in the rental of equines or equine equipment or tack or in the instruction of a person in the riding or driving of an equine or in being a passenger upon an equine is not liable for the injury or death of a person involved in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, as defined in section 895.481(1)(e) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

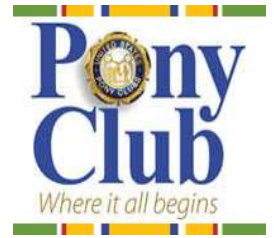
